ORDER CONCERNING DRESS IN COURTROOM

In recognition of the respect which is due the court system, and the duty of judges to promote such respect in their courtrooms, the undersigned judges of the 23<sup>rd</sup> Judicial District of Kansas enter the following orders governing their courtrooms.

**IT IS ORDERED**, That the following dress code shall be adhered to by all litigants, witnesses, jurors, court personnel, attorneys and other direct participants in court proceedings who are in the courtroom while court is in session.

**DRESS CODE FOR COURTROOM:**

No tank tops  
No halter tops  
No muscle shirts  
No bare midriffs  
No shorts except for children under 12 years of age  
No hats or caps worn  
No sweat pants or sweat suits  
Nothing worn which contains foul, obscene or disrespectful language  
No flip flops or footwear thongs  
Boots or shoes must be worn at all times  
Pants must be worn at the belt line or above  
No visible body piercing except earrings

All attorneys, as officers of the court, are directed to inform their clients and witnesses to comply with this order.






